### New Mexico Climate Change Advisory Group

### Energy Supply Technical Work Group, Call #5

Notice is hereby given to the members of the Climate Change Advisory Group of the Office of the Governor of New Mexico and to the general public that the Climate Change Advisory Group's Energy Supply Technical Work Group (TWG) will hold a teleconference call that is open to the public on Wednesday, December 21, 2005 from 9:00 to 10:30 PM. The agenda for the meeting is as follows:

1. Call to Order and Roll Call
2. Review and Approval of November 14, 2005 Teleconference Meeting #4 Summary
3. Continued Discussion and Selection of Policy Options for Initial Analysis "Short List"
  - a. The goal of this call is to focus on Sections 5 (*Electricity, Grid & Utility Policies*), 6 (*Education & Awareness*), 9 (*Fuels, Coal*), 10 (*Fuels, Hydrogen*), 11 (*Energy Supply, Emissions Policies*) of the Policy Options Matrix, identifying or "cherry picking" those items that the TWG initially wants to analyze.
  - b. Similarly, Sections 7 (*Fuels, Natural Gas & Oil Measures*) and 8 (*Fuels, Natural Gas & Oil Mechanisms*) of the Policy Options Matrix will be the focus of the next TWG call on **January 6, 2005 at 10:00-11:30 am**.
  - c. Depending on the total number of options that the TWG identifies as priorities for initial analysis, it may be necessary to further refine and/or consolidate options into a more manageable "short list" of 10-14 options to be analyzed.
4. Discussion of Policy Design Parameters (i.e., the "template" for fleshing out individual policy options), time permitting.

5. Discussion of volunteers to assist with development of “straw proposals,” time permitting.
  - a. In advance of the next CCAG meeting and after the “short list” of options for initial analysis has been finalized, small subgroups of 2-3 volunteer TWG members will be identified to develop straw proposals fleshing out policy design parameters for each option – including levels, timing, and implementation mechanisms – so that it can be modeled and analyzed. Analysis of the options will begin after the CCAG has approved the “short list” of priorities for analysis at its next meeting, and after the policy design parameters for each option have been approved by the full TWG.
