Notice and Agenda of Call:

Energy Supply Technical Work Group, Call #6

Notice is hereby given to the members of the Climate Change Advisory Group of the Office of the Governor of New Mexico and to the general public that the Climate Change Advisory Group's Energy Supply Technical Work Group (TWG) will hold a teleconference call that is open to the public on Friday, January 6 from 10:00-11:30 am. Members of the public may hear the teleconference in Room 201 in the Bataan Building on Don Gaspar in Santa Fe (across from the Roundhouse). The agenda for the meeting is as follows:

1. Call to Order and Roll Call
2. Review and Approval of December 21, 2005 Call #5 Summary
3. Continued Discussion and Selection of Policy Options for Initial Analysis "Short List"
 - a. Originally, this call was to focus on Sections 7 and 8 (*Fuels, Natural Gas & Oil Measures* and *Fuels, Natural Gas & Oil Mechanisms*) of the Policy Options Matrix, adding any new options necessary, and identifying or "cherry picking" options that the TWG wants to prioritize for initial analysis.
 - b. The productive "Straw Poll" taken during Call #4 on December 21, 2005 identified for inclusion on the initial analysis "Short List" several oil and gas policy options.
 - c. In Call #6 on January 6, 2006, the TWG should review those determinations and make any necessary additions and/or modifications, and ensure that oil and gas priority options are clear.
 - d. The TWG "Straw Poll" on December 21, 2005 identified 21 policy options as priorities for initial analysis. This sizable number of options challenges available time and resources, so the TWG may wish to refine and/or consolidate its "short list" of policy options into a more manageable number for analysis. CCS will develop and offer a consolidation proposal for discussion.

4. Identification of volunteers to assist with development of “straw proposals” and introducing the TWG’s “short list” choices to the CCAG on January 11, 2006.
 - a. Small subgroups of 2-3 volunteer TWG members will be identified to help develop straw proposals by fleshing out policy design parameters for each “short list” policy option (e.g., levels, timing, and implementation mechanisms) so that it can be modeled and analyzed. Analysis of the options will begin after the CCAG has approved the TWG’s “short list” of priorities for analysis at its January 11, 2006 meeting, and after the policy design parameters for each option have been approved by the full TWG.
5. Discussion of Policy Design Parameters (i.e., the “template” for fleshing out individual policy options), time permitting.
