 - DESCRIPTION OF FEASIBILITY ISSUES, IF NEEDED
 - STATUS OF GROUP APPROVAL

POLICY DESIGN PARAMETERS

- **INITIAL PROPOSALS FOR EACH POLICY OPTION:**
 - **LEVELS OF GHG REDUCTION BEYOND BAU IN 2012, 2020, 2050**
 - **TIMING OF REDUCTION ACTION (STARTUP AND IMPLEMENTATION)**
 - **IMPLEMENTING PARTIES/MECHANISMS**
 - **OTHER KEY DESIGN ISSUES?**

IMPLEMENTATION MECHANISMS

- **POTENTIAL IMPLEMENTATION APPROACHES FOR EACH POLICY OPTION; THESE CAN BE FINALIZED IN LATER STAGES OF DISCUSSION:**
 - INFORMATION AND EDUCATION
 - TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE
 - FUNDING MECHANISMS AND OR INCENTIVES
 - VOLUNTARY AND OR NEGOTIATED AGREEMENTS
 - CODES AND STANDARDS
 - MARKET BASED MECHANISMS
 - PILOTS AND DEMOS
 - RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT
 - REPORTING
 - REGISTRY
 - OTHER?
