TWVG Progress

- Develop initial GHG inventories and forecasts (completed)
- Identify conceivable GHG mitigation options (completed)
- Identify initial priorities for evaluation (completed)
- Evaluate GHG reduction potential and cost-effectiveness of individual options; along with contributing issues as needed (underway)
- Identify potential barriers, alternative policy design needs for individual options (underway)
- Modify, add or subtract options as needed (underway)
- Evaluate cumulative results of options against E.O. targets
- Iterate to consensus, with votes as needed
- Aggregate options into implementation scenarios
- Finalize recommendations and report language

CCAG Review and Approval of Pending Policy Options

1. TWG leader presents proposed options list with brief description of each
2. Clarifying questions by CCAG to TWG members and TWG leader
3. CCS asks for any objections by the CCAG and an explanation of specific issues if as needed
4. If no objection, draft option is approved
5. If objections, CCAG discusses potential and proposed alternatives, then votes again if needed
6. Finalize next steps for the remaining pending options for the final CCAG meeting
